

RULES REBIRTH ISLAND

Art. 1 – Info and Registration:

- **1.1** The Rebirth Island Tournament (hereinafter referred to as "competition" or "Tournament") is managed by Reghium or potential external collaborators;
- **1.2** To participate in our competitions, it is necessary to meet the minimum requirements based on the competition. The competitions may have entry fees and can include both the tournament fee and FIDE membership;
- 1.3 Registrations for our tournaments, unless otherwise communicated by the staff, must be made through the shop on our website at the following link: <u>https://shop.reghiumesports.gg/categoria-</u> <u>prodotto/tesseramenti-e-tornei/;</u>

1.4 Registration Fee:

The cost for this Tournament is 5.00€ per player (only for FIDE Members), therefore 15.00€ per team. For non-FIDE members, they must purchase the specific "Tournament Membership" product at a cost of 3,00€;

1.5 Refunds:

Refunds can be made only and exclusively until the closing of registrations, excluding FIDE Membership.

1.6 For the sole purpose of these rules, the following definitions apply:

- Game: the sum of the Matches that make up the confrontation between two associations;
- Match: the confrontation between individual players;
- Team: a group of players belonging to the same roster;
- **Coach/Team Manager:** the representative of the association responsible for communicating with the organizers and referees;
- Admin: referees appointed by the organizer to perform the functions of match officials;
- **Complaint:** reports of a technical/disciplinary nature;
- Lobby: the digital environment where Games and Matches take place;
- Ban: prohibition of participation or disallowed weapons;

Rebirth Island is a tournament conducted using Call Of Duty Warzone for Next Gen consoles and PC ("PS5, Xbox, and PC");

1.7 Eligibility:

Anyone currently banned from Call Of Duty Warzone is prohibited from participating in any competition. This prohibition will last as long as the ban is in effect;

Art. 2 – Requirements and Eligibility:

2.1 Requirements:

To participate in the competition, you must meet the following requirements:

- You must have a valid FIDE card for the current year;
- All participants must be over 16 years of age, with no exceptions of any kind;

2.2 Logos and Photos:

All teams representing an Association and/or a Company are required, at the time of registration, to provide their logo without a background in .png or vector format (.ai, .eps, or .pdf). Additionally, a photo of their players is required (No selfies. The photo should be as professional as possible. Example photo: www.reghiumesports.gg/fotoesempioplayer);

2.3 Registration and Acceptance of Rules:

To be considered eligible, players must review and accept the Competition Rules. Once a player has registered, they are considered eligible for the entire tournament, as indicated in point 3 of the rules **(3. Competition Structure and General Rules)**;

2.4 Age:

Players must be at least 16 years old. Any player younger than the required age will be considered ineligible to participate;

2.5 Technical Issues:

Players are responsible for their hardware, software, and internet connection. Matches will not be rescheduled or temporarily suspended due to technical issues related to their devices;

2.6 Connection:

Each player must strive to have the best possible in-game ping; all unnecessary downloads during Matches must be paused. Abuse of this rule may lead to disqualification from the tournament;

2.7 Unsportsmanlike Behavior:

To ensure a pleasant and orderly experience, it is essential that all players maintain sportsmanship during matches. Violations of this rule will result in penalties in the competition standings. Every player must participate to the best of their abilities. Any behavior that damages the atmosphere of fair play will be considered unsportsmanlike and will be punished according to the severity by the organizer. This includes, but is not limited to, spam, insults, trolling, and unsportsmanlike behavior towards other players, teams, casters, or staff.

Art. 3 – Competition Structure and General Rules:

3.1 Lobby Settings:

All players must adhere to the established settings and rules. Agreements differing from them are not allowed and will not be tolerated unless approved by an admin. Below are the settings that must be used to create a lobby.

- Game Mode: Private Trios;
- Lobby Open: Ore 21.00;
- Lobby Start: Ore 21.10;



3.2 Lobby Code:

The lobby code will be communicated approximately 10 minutes before each game to allow each team to settle in with the number of players as communicated at the time of registration;

3.3 Screenshot:

At the end of each game, the team leader and/or player from each squad must, within 10 minutes, post the kills and placement of the team in the designated private Discord channel to have an updated real-time ranking game after game.

NOTE: After the aforementioned 10 minutes, if there are no photos and/or verified results, the game will be considered void for those teams;

3.4 Scores and Rankings:

Registration includes a total of 6 games; the best 5 games will be counted for the final score, calculated based on each player's kills multiplied by the team placement multiplier (listed below):

- Each kill is worth 1 point;
- 1st Place: multiplier x2;
- 2nd and 3rd Place: multiplier x1,8;
- 4th and 5th Place: multiplier x1,50;
- 6th to 10th Place: multiplier x1,30.

NOTA: The winning team (3 players) of the last game will receive free registration for the next tournament;

3.5 Bans:

If a player commits an infraction under these rules, they will be penalized with a deduction of 5 points from the total points of the current game.

To verify any infraction/misconduct, it will be necessary to submit the incriminating clip within the dedicated section.

The decision to assign penalty points will be solely up to the tournament admins.

Contesting the admin's decision may result in further point deductions for the team found guilty of such behavior.

The team harmed by the player who committed an infraction under these rules will receive a 3-point bonus in the current game.

3.6 Limitations:

In case of imminent evasion, teams completely eliminated (without a single player alive) must crash to the ground, while those with at least 1 player alive, upon the appearance of the "imminent evasion" alert, will be allowed to re-enter the game and finish the match.

Violation of this article will result in a sanction under article 3.5.

The use of a maximum of 1 sniper per team is allowed;

3.7 Restart Match:

To ensure smooth gameplay, the lobby will be restarted in case of crashes affecting at least 10% of the participants;

3.8 Streaming:

For PC players, streaming on the Twitch platform is mandatory; in case of report, the use of a monitor cam may be requested.

Art. 4 – Prize Pool:

4.1 Prize Pool:

The guaranteed prize pool for this event is 150,00€

- **1st Place:** 90,00€;
- 2nd Place: 60,00€;

If there are additional registrations beyond the base prize pool, the staff will consider increasing the total amount.

4.2 Prize Delivery:

The prize will be delivered the day after the competition via PayPal or bank transfer directly to the Team Leader. Additional recognition for tournament winners through posts and Instagram stories. Inclusion in the Palmares on the "Reghium Championship" website.

4.3 Reghium Championship Points Ranking:

Reghium Esports ASD offers the opportunity to enter the "Reghium Championship" ranking to access additional prizes. This tournament is classified as "Grade 6".



- 1st Place: 755 Points;
- 2nd Place: 683 Points;
- 3rd Place: 510 Points;
- 4th Place: 302 Points;
- 5th Place: 250 Points;
- 6th Place: 193 Points;

4.4 Reghium Coin:

Reghium Coins are a virtual currency that can be used in our shop to redeem additional prizes. For this "Grade 6" tournament, the following Reghium Coins will be awarded:

- 1st Place: 279 Reghium Coins;
- 2nd Place: 212 Reghium Coins;
- 3rd Place: 176 Reghium Coins;
- 4th Place: 85 Reghium Coins;
- 5th Place: 84 Reghium Coins;
- 6th Place: 83 Reghium Coins;

NOTA: To receive Reghium Coins, registration on the Reghium shop is required.

Art. 5 – Advertising and Image Rights:

5.1 All participants grant Reghium Esports ASD permission to use names, nicknames, player tags, email addresses, phone numbers, and logos for advertising purposes and waive any claim to royalties or rights for such use.

Art. 6 – Disputes, Conduct, and Other Info:

6.1 Complaints:

If an irregular situation occurs, whether or not described in this regulation, the team noticing it must immediately inform the administrators about it with screenshots and/or videos;

6.2 Conduct:

All participants must conduct themselves in a polite and respectful manner towards opponents and admins. Therefore, insults, racial, sexual, and religious discriminations, as well as behaviors aimed at offending the sensibility of other users, and unsportsmanlike behaviors are strictly prohibited;

6.3 Support:

6.4 Changes:

The staff reserves the right to modify the regulations at any time;

6.5 Decisions:

In special cases, some decisions may be made by the organization even if not covered by any specific rule, to preserve the spirit of fair competition and sportsmanship.



The competition will be monitored by our admins to ensure compliance with the rules. All players are required to know the regulations and report any irregularities before matches begin. Once the opponents agree to play, they assume responsibility for verifying that all game conditions comply with the regulations, and therefore the result, except in exceptional circumstances which will be evaluated by the event organizers. Disqualification is also provided for in cases of misconduct such as blasphemy, insults, or unsportsmanlike behavior towards opponents or staff. If, due to technical reasons or other issues beyond the control of the players involved in the match, the game is abruptly interrupted (for example, power outage), the match will be replayed from the beginning without considering the previous result. However, it will be up to the staff to decide whether to replay the match depending on the circumstances that occurred.
